





In 2010 107 staff members from 24 different countries worked at the Headquarters and Regional Offices, thus contributing a total of 69 person-years to the institute's activities.









The future of EU Research: Horizon 2020

EU's next Financial Framework to support Research and Innovation

- Commission proposal in MFF: **EUR 80 Billion for 2014-2020** (+ contribution from Structural funds)
- 3 strategic objectives: i) tackling major societal challenges, ii) increasing competitiveness and iii) raising the levels of excellence in the research base.
- 4.5 bn earmarked for food security and bio-based economy







- The forest-based sector is a global leader of the bio-economy
- In 20 years it has doubled the added value of its products and services
- Consumer needs, and the smart and sustainable use of forest resources, are the cornerstones of development
- Strategic partnerships and SMEs speed up the time from innovations to market
- The forest-based sector delivers eco-services and eco-efficient products from wood and wood-based products, paper and packaging, to green energy, biofuels, textile fibres and chemicals
