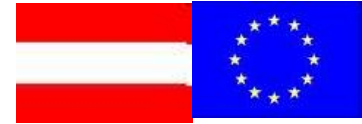

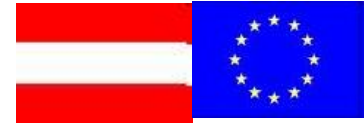


Scholarships for Postgraduates + Post-Docs

1. Ernst-Mach scholarship

- for Graduates, Postgraduates, PhD holders
- Maximum age: 35
- duration 1-9 months
- monthly rate: 940 . 1040 Euro
- accident and health insurance as well as accommodation provided by ÖAD, monthly cost: 220-470 Euro
- recipients are exempted from tuition fees
- Application deadlines:
01.03. for the following academic year

Scholarships for Postgraduates + Postdocs



2. EURASIA-Pacific-Net Technology Scholarships (for member institutions of the network)

- for Postgraduates and Post-Docs
- Maximum age: No age limit
- duration 2-9 months (2 . 7 months for Post Docs)
- monthly rate: 940 . 1040 Euro
- accident and health insurance as well as accommodation provided by ÖAD, monthly cost: 220-470 Euro
- recipients are exempted from tuition fees
- Application deadlines: depending on the home university

Scholarships for Postdocs

3. Lise Meitner Postdoc Programme of the FWF

- for postdocs (researchers) who haven't yet spent a research visit of more than 6 months in Austria
- grant for 12 up to 24 months, renewal not possible
- Application deadline: any time
- Apply at: FWF (<http://www.fwf.ac.at>)
- Application must be endorsed by an Austrian co-applicant (who will act as employer)
- Age limit: 40
- EUR 60.610 (Postdoc) or EUR 66.680 (Senior-Postdoc) / year + up to 10.000 Euro for travel cost, material etc.

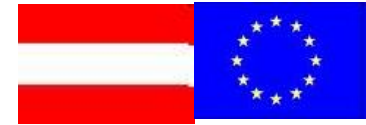
Scholarships for Postdocs

4. PEOPLE - Marie Curie Incoming International Fellowships

- is a grant within the 7th EU Framework Programme
- eligible: PhD holders OR researchers with at least four years of full-time research experience
- monthly living and mobility allowances plus a contribution to the host organisation to for expenses related to the research activity
- duration: 12 - 48 months
- IIF (International Incoming Fellowships) Deadline: August (14.8.2013)
- CIG (Career Integration Grants) Deadline: March / Sept. (18.9.20 13)
